## **Developing meaningful assessment ideas for and of learning (KS2 and KS3)**

**Susi Sahmland** is a lecturer in education at Goldsmiths, where she is MFL secondary lecturer and runs the Primary Languages Course. Susi taught German, Spanish and French from KS1 to KS5 in central London schools. After gaining Advanced Skills Teacher status, she was seconded to the City of Westminster to implement the government's Primary Modern Foreign Languages strategy, delivering training to groups, working with individual teachers and leading network meetings.

**Judith Rifesser** is a teacher-researcher with ample experience in teaching MFL and EAL in secondary and primary school, and in higher education. She is a Teaching Fellow in German at UCL CLIE and a Visiting Lecturer in the Dept of Media, Culture and Language at the University of Roehampton. Previously Head of KS5 German, CPD facilitator for Teaching and Learning and Lead Subject Mentor for MFL PGCE students, she recently co-published a chapter on context-embedded assessment for learning in the TL with UCL IOE Press.
